“I know I might be treated differently when I get back to school because I have changed a bit I’m different. I’m worried about people making fun of my wheelchair.

Mum says that if anyone makes any funny comments about my wheelchair I should tell a teacher. It’s not telling tales, it’s making sure I can go to school and not get bullied for something I have no control over.

Most people understand more about people in wheelchairs these days. Kids can be tricky though and sometimes say really cruel things. No-one should ever be bullied because they are in a wheelchair or have a disability. The school should always deal with it if this is a problem for you; make sure you speak up if this does happen.”
