Mum says that the teachers will know about this when I start back. I'm going to find it difficult because I used to like school and found the work quite easy. Mum says I need to be patient and take a one day at a time.

After rehabilitation, things might change or at least they might be easier. The teachers can then decide what is best for me when I get back.

The teachers at school won't set me things I can't do and they will make sure that I'm not struggling. In the meantime, it is best just to focus on adjusting."
